A video (**.wmv**) or audio (**mp3**) file will do. Keep it simple. Just answer the following questions in plain language. (Please limit jargon and acronyms.)

- **Who are you?** State your name and job title (within Software Group) at IBM.
- **What do you do at IBM?** Briefly again, and in plain language. For example, are you a marketing professional who helps small business clients fully understand the benefits of Lotus Software offerings for them?
- **Why does it matter?** Are you helping small businesses work smarter? Contributing to a smarter planet? Tell us a brief story about a cool project you're working on that made a difference. (An example could be how you helped one client save extra money that s/he used toward green office technology.)
- **Add an ending:** Restate your first and last name and add "I'm an IBMer." (Example: "I'm Jane Doe, and I'm an IBMer.")
